### CAMP COWABUNGA REFUND POLICY:

Seven (7) business days\* before the program starts, payees may receive a full refund (minus a \$10.00 administrative fee). Requests must be made no later than 7 business days before the program start date. If a request for reimbursement is made after the 7 day period but 3 business days before the program starts, a \$50.00 late request penalty will be accessed along with the \$10.00 administrative fee. Payees are not entitled to refunds requested less than 3 business days before the program begins.\*Our regular business day schedule is Monday-Friday, 7am-5pm.
